Thematic Title : The Responsibility Behavior of Lay Students Joining Morning

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ABSTRACT

This research was inspired from the responsibility behavior of lay students joining class in the morning, Mahamakut Buddhist University– Isan Campus. The objectives focused on the responsibility behavior of lay students, the correlation of individual factors with the responsibility behavior and the way leading to support the lay students to be responsibility by the use of questionnaire. All 70 subjects (from 136) or 50 % from systematic sampling were participated in this study. The data were analyzed and processed by computer for percentage, mean, standard deviation and chi-square.

The results were found that:-

- 1. As a whole, the responsibility behavior of lay students was good. To consider in each section, the research found that family responsibility and friend responsibility were excellent. Self responsibility, university responsibility and social responsibility were good.
 - 2. Gender had correlation with levels of responsibility behavior at 0.05.
- 3. Age, class and facalty had no correlation with levels of responsibility behavior at 0.05.
